

IMPROVING NUTRITION IN MALAWI

amongst children...

13% are **underweight**

38% are **stunted**

92% do not meet **minimum acceptable diet**

54% in the past **2 weeks** had **diarrhea**

amongst women (15-49)...

Almost **3 in 4** face moderate or **severe hunger**

82% do not meet **minimum dietary diversity**

91% went to **school** however, of these women **37%** did not complete **primary education** **40%** cannot read **a sentence**

2% have acute **malnourishment**

11% do not work for income outside the home

89% manage land for crops but only **16%** have power to **make decisions** about its use

and in households...

77% get water from an **improved water source**

34% of women walk over **30 minutes** to get water

68% of all babies are exclusively **breastfed**
